

TIMES AND RATES OF PLAY

Play starts promptly 9.30am. This is a single-section, six-round, Swiss tournament and all players play in every round. Each player has 30 minutes to complete all moves. Players not present 15 minutes after the start of a round will default the game. Players may be re-paired. Please note that the control team's decisions on any matter will be final.

ENTRY FEES

Women: £15
Under 18: £12

There is a £2 reduction in the entry fee for BWCA members. Anyone joining at the tournament will have £2 deducted from the membership fee.

Late entry fee: £2 for entries after 5 February.

Entries will be accepted up to 9.15am on the day.

Parents and teachers: supervision of juniors is not provided. A high standard of behaviour is expected at all times.

Coaching will be available between rounds.

PRIZES

The first prize will be £50 and the winner will also receive a trophy.

Titles, trophies, minimum first prizes of £20 and minimum second prizes of £10 will be awarded to the highest-scoring eligible under 16 and under 21 player(s). In the event of a tie, titles, trophies and prizes will be shared.

There will be a best game prize of £20. Cash prizes may be increased in size or number depending on the entry. Every competitor will receive a certificate.

PRIZEGIVING

Prizegiving will be at about 6.00pm and all competitors are requested to attend.

REFRESHMENTS are available within the hotel: food may not be taken into the playing areas.

The British Women's Chess Association has designed this event to provide an opportunity for women and girls to play chess in a supportive and sociable environment where coaching is available free of charge.

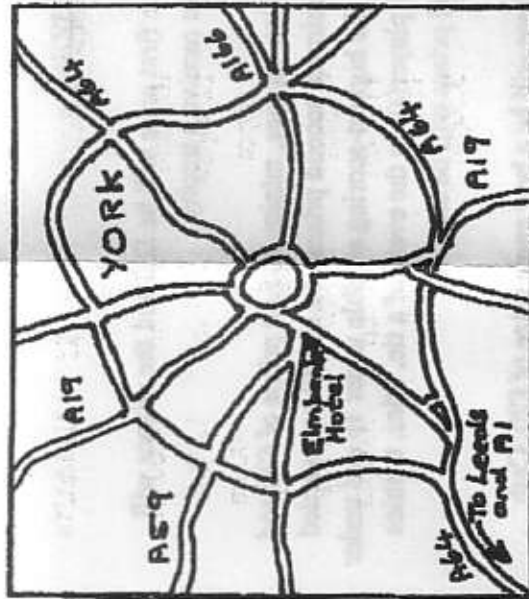
The Under 16 and under 21 championships provide a national title.

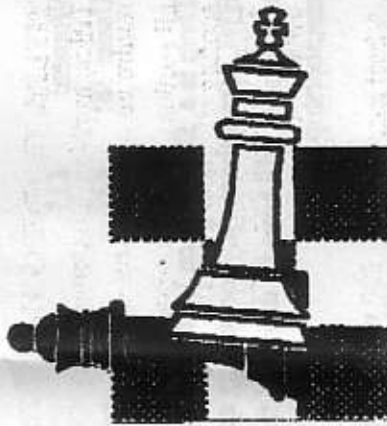

DIRECTIONS
