



# Leeds Junior Chess Congress 2011

Part of the Yorkshire Junior Grand Prix  
The best tournament for top juniors & those attending their first event

Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2011

## Major Section:

Open to any player but particularly those with an ECF/YCA grade **115 or above** or by invitation of the Organisers. Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> £50, 2<sup>nd</sup> £25, 3<sup>rd</sup> £15. An extra grading prize of £10 may also be awarded. Trophy for the winner.

## Intermediate Section

Open to players with an ECF/YCA grade **below 115**

Trophies for the top 3. Best girl & second girl medal. Age group prizes for boys and girls may be awarded depending on entry.

## Minor Section

Open to any player with **no grade or below 40 (some tournament experience would be required)**.

Trophies for the top 3. Best girl medal. Medals in each age group for best boy and girl (U14,U11,U10,U9,U8 and U7) even if there is only one entry in the age/gender group.

## Novice Section (age limit 11 years of age – unless with consent of Organisers)

Open to any player with limited experience or first tournament.

Trophy for the overall winner and then medals in each age group for best boy and girl (U11,U10,U9,U8 and U7) even if there is only one entry in the age/gender group. Certificates to all participants.

No player can win more than one trophy or medal (unless it cannot be awarded to anyone else). If trophies are won in any section – the age medal will be awarded to the next highest scoring junior. Tie breaks (in the form of a play off match) will be used in the event of a tie for all trophies and medals (except in the Minor and Novice where medals will be awarded to tied players). Cash prizes will be shared.

Extra non cash prizes may be awarded depending on size of entry on all sections except the Major.

You do not need to have played in any other grand prix events to enter this tournament.

Grand Prix prizes will also be awarded.

There will also be a trophy for the best Leeds player (lives or attends a school in the Leeds post code).

Entry fees: Major: £12.00. Intermediate: £10. Minor: £8. Novice: £7

## Yorkshire Junior Chess Association members may deduct £2.

(Refreshments may be on sale but you are advised to bring a packed lunch). Entries received without payment eg by e-mail will be accepted but will have an extra £2 charge on the day. Refunds given for withdrawal before Monday 31<sup>st</sup> January. **NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY.** Closing date for entries is Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February at 9pm.

The organisers are only responsible for juniors in the playing hall. We strongly recommend juniors are supervised when they are not playing. It is a condition of entry that photographs may be taken and used for publicity. If you do not wish photographs of your child to be used you must tell us when you register on the day. Photos may appear on the YCA, Leeds Junior Chess and ECF websites.

Program for intermediate event: Arrive 9.45am. Round 1 10am, Round 2 11am, Round 3 12noon, Round 4 1pm, Round 5 2pm, Round 6 3pm, Prize giving 4.15pm. Rounds may be brought forward if all games finish early.

The minor and novice event may follow a different program depending on numbers but will start with Round 1 at 10am and end with prize giving at 4.15pm. The organisers may alter this program depending on entry numbers in the sections.
