

Getting There

We advise those coming by car and using the **M40 to leave the motorway at junction 4**. Then drive for 500 metres on the A404 towards Wycombe town centre past the sports centre. At the roundabout turn left and immediately right into Wycombe High School. There are two car parks in the school grounds or the pay and display at the sports centre.

By rail, High Wycombe is on the Chiltern line. There are taxi's close by the station. It is only a 1 mile journey south on the A404 but Marlow Hill is a long steep hill for those considering walking.

Any Under 9 wishing to play in the Under 12 Championship must play in at least one of the events that would allow an Under 11 to be picked for the England Trial. These events are

Under 11 English Open, British Rapidplay, London Junior Under 12 Major, EPSCA Rapidplay Championships, Liverpool, South of England, West of England.
Any player who scores 50% or better in one of these events is allowed to play in the Under 12 Championships. You must state this on your entry.

Championship Trophies, Titles and Place Prizes
Full prize lists will be displayed at the Venue. Tied Titles and Cash prizes will be shared. National Chess Junior Squad Trophies will be awarded to all players sharing first place in each event

An Under 14 clear winner of the Under 16 event will hold both Championship Trophies and Titles.
Mini Squad Championship Trophies and Titles will be offered at Under 10, 9, 8 and 7 levels. An Under 6 Trophy may be awarded if entries merit this.

School Terms and Byes

Players unable to attend on the Friday because of the school term will be allowed to take two half point byes for the Friday games. Players are advised not to abuse this offer. For other players one half point bye is allowed. Please make this clear on your entry form.

Mini Squad Championship

The Mini Squad Championship is a two day event designed to allow players from all over the country to attend.

Ages are calculated as at midnight 31st Aug 2005

Clocks will be used on all boards in all events.

All games must be recorded except in the Under 8.

All advertised prizes are guaranteed

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry.

Please note that membership of the National Chess Junior Squad is by invitation only: you cannot join the Squad with this entry form. This form simply enables any eligible junior to play in the Championships.

Late Arrivals for any round

Players arriving after the re-pairing time of 30 minutes in the Squad events, 15 minutes in the Mini-Squad events, may be deemed to have lost by default, unless the controller can pair them satisfactorily. Players whose opponents have not arrived must expect to be re-paired.
